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Anterior Labral Repair/Bankart Repair Protocol

Days 0-20

- Immobilization: Sling with abduction pillow worn continuously until 6 weeks post-op.
- ROM: PROM to 140 degrees of flexion; 90 degrees of abduction; 20 degrees of ER; IR as tolerated.

Elbow, wrist, hand ROM.

• Strength:

Grip strengthening.

Isometric ABD, ER, IR with elbow at side.

Davs 21-41

• ROM: PROM to 60 degrees of ER. Increase to full PROM all other planes as tolerated.

Day 42 (end of week 6)

- Immobilization: DC sling.
- **ROM:** Increase to full ROM all planes as tolerated.

Begin gentle joint mobs.

Begin pulleys/canes and other exercises for ROM.

• Strength:

Continue elbow/wrist/hand ROM and grip strengthening.

Begin prone extension and scapular stabilization exercises.

Advance isometrics to use of a theraband.

Day 49 (end of week 7)

- **ROM:** Progress to full AROM without pain.
- Strength:

Advance theraband exercises with use of weights.

Begin UBE.

Continue PRE and total arm strengthening.

End of week 12 to 6 months

- Full ROM without discomfort
- May return to weight room at 12 weeks
- Exercise:

Advance into more functional strengthening. Begin functional progression to work/sport.

End of 6 months

• Return to competitive sports including contact sports if approved.
