Frequently Asked Questions

What Is Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP)?

PRP is a platelet and cell enriched product that could be used by your doctor as a surgical or non-surgical therapy to signal your body's natural healing potential.

How Many Visits are Required?

The exact number of PRP visits will vary from patient to patient. While some patients may see results after a single PRP visit, multiple visits may be required. Your physician will recommend a PRP plan specific to your need.

How Long do the Results Last?

Results can be long lasting and vary based on your doctors recommendation. Initial improvements could be evident within the first few weeks following your first PRP visit, and continue throughout the healing process. Please consult with your physician.

Depending on your medical need your physician may recommend a Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP) treatment. Before you begin your recommended treatment, it is important that you understand what to expect from the procedure and how PRP works naturally with your body.

Platelet-Rich Plasma (PRP) is concentrated platelets and white blood cells derived from your own blood.

Prior to your procedure, a small sample of blood is drawn. The blood is placed in a specialized centrifuge that will separate and concentrate your body's own natural healing agents, in less than 20 minutes. The Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP) is then applied to the site. The platelets activate and release growth factors, which helps your body's natural healing process.

After the application, you may feel mild discomfort at the blood draw and/or injection site(s) depending on the procedure.

Please ask your MAO physician for post treatment instructions.

PERSONALIZED MEDICINE

+ COLLECT

Your physician will draw blood from your vein with a small needle.

+ CONCENTRATE

A centrifuge separates and concentrates the cellular components of blood. The resulting product is a highly concentrated suspension of platelets and cells (PRP).

+ DELIVER

The PRP is returned to the designated site(s) during your same office visit.
